1 The Court having considered the Amended Omnibus Objection to Employee
2 Claims ("Objection") of Thomas A. Seaman ("Receiver"), Court-appointed
3 permanent receiver for Medical Capital Holdings, Inc., Medical Capital
4 Corporation, Medical Provider Funding Corporation VI, and their subsidiaries and
5 affiliates, together with all papers filed in support of and opposition to the
6 Objection, and good cause appearing therefor, hereby orders as follows:

7 1. The proposed allowed claim amounts for employee claims, listed under
8 the column entitled "Total Claim," on Exhibit F to the Supplemental Declaration of
9 Thomas Seaman filed on February 28, 2012 (Docket No. 658) are approved, except
10 as provided herein.

11 2. The claims of Alan Meister, William Noll and Gary Urbanowicz are
12 equitably subordinated to all other allowed noteholder, trade creditor and employee
13 claims. These claimants shall receive no distributions until all allowed noteholder,
14 trade creditor and employee claims have been paid in full.

15 3. The claim of Cynthia Dunckelmann is allowed in the amount of
16 \$7,765.24.

17 4. The claim of Jorge Montalvo is allowed in the amount of \$2,579.05.

18 5. The request for waiting time penalties and attorney fees submitted by
19 the group of employees represented by attorney Robert Johnson is denied.

20 6. The Receiver's objections to the claims of Arely Morales, Judith
21 Begley and Joy Dominguez are continued to March 19, 2012 at 3:00 p.m. On
22 March 12, 2012, the Receiver shall give notice to claimants Morales, Begley and
23 Dominguez that he is seeking subordination of their claims on equitable grounds.
24 Claimants Morales, Begley and Dominguez shall submit a response to the Receiver
25 no later than March 14, 2012.

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1 7. The Receiver's objections to the claims of Christian Tureaud, David
2 Salzberg and Jason French, if not resolved by the parties, will be heard on May 11,
3 2012 at 3:00 p.m.
