PROCEEDING (IN CHAMBERS): ORDER REGARDING COURT APPROVAL OF RECEIVER'S
SALE OF ASSETS

From today's date, the Receiver need not seek court approval of the sale of assets for less than \$1 million. However, the Receiver shall file a notice of all such sales with the Court at least three (3) weeks prior to the finalization of said sale. Should any party believe that special circumstances warrant a hearing and court approval of the sale, that party shall file an *ex parte* application asking for the scheduling of a hearing within three (3) days of the Receiver filing notice of the sale with this Court.
